Several new features have been added to Version 5 (V5) of E-IRB specifically for Reliance applications for which **UK is ceding IRB review to another institution/entity**.

To-date, the researcher's "Yes" response to the 'Project Information' question, highlighted in yellow in the screen shot below, triggers review by the Reliance Team:

And subsequently, when applicable, the researcher should mark the "This protocol is approved by a Non-UK IRB." attribute in the Exemption Categories subsection of the E-IRB application:

For applications the Reliance Team has verified IRB review will be ceded, an approval period of two years will initially be granted, effective after noon, October 23, 2024.

After two years, initially, then yearly, if a "Reliance Renewal" (RR) has not occurred, E-IRB will automatically prompt the researcher by email to submit an "RR".

The Exempt application for which **UK IRB review has been ceded** has a menu option "Modification Request (MR)/Reliance Renewal." Clicking this new menu option will create a "Reliance Renewal" application which will give the researcher the opportunity to modify the protocol, add information from the IRB review of record, and/or verify that the research activities are ongoing and UK is receiving data and materials from the reviewing IRB in a timely manner.
