


"The original Bucks for Brains program has been a catalyst for recruiting and retaining world-class talent at the University of Kentucky. The holders of chairs and professorships created through our partnership with the state have been essential to the University's ability to make and sustain dramatic progress in the number of research dollars we bring to Kentucky. B. Mark Evers, Markey Cancer Foundation Chair

A “shining star,” a “top-tier director,” an “accomplished surgeon and prolific researcher.” These were some of the accolades used to describe B. Mark Evers at the April 2009 press conference announcing his appointment as the new Director of the Markey Cancer Center. But what stood out most was his modesty. “There’s been a lot of talk about me,” Evers told the audience. “And I’m very embarrassed about that, because I normally like to fly under the radar.” But Evers is on everyone’s radar. His research made headlines in 2006 when he discovered that the active ingredient in turmeric, a curry spice, could suppress the growth and migration of colon cancer cells. And his impact at the University of Texas Medical Branch, where he spent 21 years and created a second family, was clear when 32 of his colleagues followed Evers to UK. He’s already made a big impact in Kentucky: Evers leads a SPORE (Specialized Program in Research Excellence) grant in gastrointestinal cancers. The three-year, \$1.5 million grant will help UK recruit researchers and develop more targeted therapies for colon and liver cancer. The Markey Cancer Center has one of six GI SPOREs in the nation.

FOCUS ON FACULTY

Brent Seales, Jack and Linda Gill Science and Engineering Professor

In 79 A.D. Mount Vesuvius erupted, burying the cities of Pompeii and Herculaneum. In the 18th century, an ancient library in a Herculaneum villa yielded 1,800 papyrus scrolls, some that were so badly damaged—literally turned to carbon by the volcanic heat—that they crumbled into dust when scholars tried to open them. Half of the Herculaneum scrolls have been read, but the other half will require space-age technology to decipher their secrets. UK computer scientist Brent Seales has been working on just such a technology in an NSF-funded project called EDUCE (Enhanced Digital Unwrapping for Conservation and Exploration). Seales and his team spent this past July at the French National Academy in Paris, ardently making CT scans of two of these unopened Herculaneum scrolls. Seales brought back two terabytes of data that will be processed at UK’s Center for Visualization and Virtual Environments to produce 3-D images of the scrolls. His goal is to digitally “unroll” the scrolls, so scholars can read them. Scholars think the scrolls contain writings by Philodemus, a Roman philosopher. The readability of the scrolls may hinge on the ink used. Seales is hoping it was a metal-based ink. He says if the ink is carbon-based, it might not be possible to visually separate it from the carbonized papyrus.





Natasha Kyprianou, James F. Hardymon Chair of Urology Research

Approximately 234,000 new cases of prostate cancer will be diagnosed in the United States, and 30,000 men will die from prostate cancer this year. Haining Zhu in Biochemistry and Natasha Kyprianou in Urology are leading a team of UK researchers to identify protein markers in prostate cancer cells that indicate a likelihood of spreading diseased cells. With a \$1.1 million grant from the Department of Defense, the research team is using mass spectrometry to identify "proteins of interest" in prostate cancer cells. These proteins have been identified as susceptible to being spread to other organs. Metastasis of prostate tumor cells to other organs, primarily to the bone and lymph nodes, is the main cause of death for prostate cancer patients. The research could lead to new diagnostic tests that could head off the spread of prostate cancer cells to other tissue in the lungs, liver, and other organs, and could reveal new protein targets for therapeutic prostate cancer treatment. Zhu and Kyprianou have collaborated on this research area for more than three years. Their partnership resulted in a Synergistic Idea Development Award (SIDA) grant from the Department of Defense. The proposal was one of only five awarded nationwide under the SIDA program in 2008.

Bruce Hinds, William Bryan Professor in Chemical and Materials Engineering

It's not every day the President of the United States recognizes your research. But that's exactly what happened for Bruce Hinds. He was one of 100 researchers nationwide to receive the Presidential Early Career Award for Scientists and Engineers, the highest honor bestowed by the federal government on scientists in the early stages of their independent research careers. Hinds' work focuses on nanoscale device fabrication. *Science* and *Nature* magazines featured reports on Hinds' research that discovered a way to make carbon nanotube membranes allow fluids to flow through at a rate 10,000 times faster than normal materials, "which means membranes and filters can be 10,000 times smaller and more energy efficient," Hinds says. Membranes are a critical component of a wide range of industrial processes including chemical production, energy storage, food processing, water purification, and medical devices. The work recognized by the Obama Administration was NIH-funded research to use this membrane to pump drugs, using very small voltages, in a programmable skin patch device for drug addiction treatment. Hinds' work has been funded by the NIH, NSF, Air Force, Army, Defense Advanced Research Projects Agency, Department of Energy, Kentucky Science and Engineering Foundation, and industry.



Eugenia Toma, Wendell H. Ford Professor of Public Policy

How do you address the stubborn problem of academic underperformance in central Appalachia, where students consistently score below state averages in math and science? Target teachers. That's the goal of a \$24-million NSF-funded program called the Appalachian Math and Science Partnership (AMSP). With UK as the lead institution, AMSP created a partnership among 56 central Appalachian school districts, 10 higher education institutions, and the Kentucky Science and Technology Corporation. Since the program began in 2003, more than 400 schools from four states have participated. But is the program, which emphasizes professional development for teachers, working? Yes. The stats from Eugenia Toma's pilot project prove it: "We found improvement for seventh-grade science scores, eighth-grade math scores, and 11th-grade math and science scores." Among the more specific findings: "After controlling for other factors, if the percentage of teachers participating in AMSP professional development within a school is increased by 1 percent, math scores of 11th-graders rise by .29 points." With such promising preliminary research, Toma received an additional \$1.5 million NSF grant to further substantiate these gains. The new study will conclude in September 2011.



Lumy Sawaki, Cardinal Hill Endowed Research Scholar in Stroke and Spinal Cord Injury Rehabilitation

A stroke often leads to lifelong disability. At least that used to be the case. In the past two decades scientists have learned that the brain is able to relearn and redirect more activity after a stroke than previously imagined. Brain rewiring can occur even for patients who had a stroke 10 or 20 years ago. UK's Lumy Sawaki is on the leading-edge of this research. Her tools include constraint-induced movement therapy (where a stroke patient's fully functional arm is restricted in a mitten to force the weaker arm to compensate) and transcranial magnetic stimulation (a noninvasive method that induces weak electric current in the patient's motor cortex, the part of the brain that plans and executes movement). Mapping the areas of activity before and after treatment allows Sawaki to capture how the brain rewrites itself. Sawaki says, "I have the tools here to 'facilitate' the rewiring process, but it's the effort and desire of the patient that ultimately determines the outcome. I'm simply helping these people help themselves."

FOCUS ON STUDENTS

The Endowment Match Program is not only a mechanism to recruit faculty. It also provides research opportunities and financial support for some of the most talented graduate students in the U.S. In Fiscal Year 2009, the Endowment Match Program provided graduate fellowships to 368 recipients.



FOCUS ON KENTUCKY

Bucks for Brains is a primary catalyst for the substantial growth in the external research funding coming to campus and to Kentucky. In Fiscal Year 2009, external research grants and contracts at the University totaled \$256.7 million (www.research.uky.edu/publications/research2009.pdf). This is up from \$122 million in 1997 (a 110 percent increase).

These dollars have an impact on UK's campus. During Fiscal Year 2009, these external research grants and contracts resulted in a \$367.4 million contribution to the Kentucky economy, including \$193.4 million in personal income. Externally supported research accounted for 9,331 jobs at UK and throughout Kentucky. Each dollar of out-of-state external funding for research generates approximately \$1.91 of total related expenditures.

ENDOWMENT ACTIVITY


The University of Kentucky, having fully matched all available funds from the first three rounds of the Endowment Match Program, has received \$202,190,929 in state funds. Since 1998, the University of Kentucky has used Bucks for Brains to:

- create 87 endowed chairs and 206 endowed professorships; and
- create 238 fellowships, lectures, enrichments, and endowments for research support and the William T. Young Library (Table 1).

UK currently has 307 active patents on campus, primarily in pharmaceuticals, plant biotechnology, and biomedical engineering. UK collected \$1,659,296 in royalties from 151 total licenses of intellectual property in Fiscal Year 2009.

In 2007, more startup companies were formed by University of Kentucky faculty and staff entrepreneurs than at any of UK's 19 benchmark institutions per \$10 million in annual research expenditures, according to a recently released report by the Association of University Technology Managers (AUTM). UK's benchmark institutions include the universities of Wisconsin, Maryland, Michigan, Illinois and Florida.

AUTM, a global network of more than 350 universities, research institutions, teaching hospitals, and government agencies as well as hundreds of companies, also reported that UK climbed from 29th in 2005 to 7th in 2007 among all public and private universities in developing new technology-based businesses. In the area of licensing, UK ranked 13th in licensing income compared to its benchmarks.

DEMOGRAPHIC INFORMATION

As of June 30, 2009, the University of Kentucky has appointed a total of 185 faculty to endowed chairs and professorships under the auspices of the Endowment Match Program. Of those appointments, 149 (81 percent) are male, and 36 (19 percent) are female. Of the 815 professional staff associated with the Bucks for Brains program, 370 (45.4 percent) are male, and 445 (54.6 percent) are female. (Table 2)

During Fiscal Year 2009, there were 129 endowments supporting graduate fellowships. Since a single endowment may support multiple student awards, 368 graduate students received support from endowment proceeds (Table 4). There were 161 (43.8 percent) minority students among fellowship recipients.

AREAS OF CONCENTRATION

The Council on Postsecondary Education's 2002-04 Endowment Match Program Guidelines stipulate that at least 70 percent of program funds at the research institutions must be used to support Research Challenge programs or academic disciplines contained within Kentucky's five new economy clusters: (1) human health and development; (2) biosciences; (3) materials science and advanced manufacturing; (4) information technologies and communications; and (5) environmental and energy technologies. The University of Kentucky directed 82.8 percent of the 2002-04 funds to support positions, programs, or projects within the new economy clusters (Table 5).

Pursuant to the 2002-04 Endowment Match Program Guidelines, the University also directed 72.2 percent of program funds to support chairs, professorships or research scholars, and infrastructure or fellowships directly linked to the research activities of endowed chairs and professors.

FINANCIAL SUMMARY

As previously noted, there was no new endowment activity during FY 2008-09 as the University of Kentucky had fully matched its share of the 2002-04 Endowment Match Program funds. As of June 30, 2009, the market value of all endowments created since the inception of the Research Challenge Trust Fund Endowment Match Program in 1998 is \$313,782,709 (Table 6).
